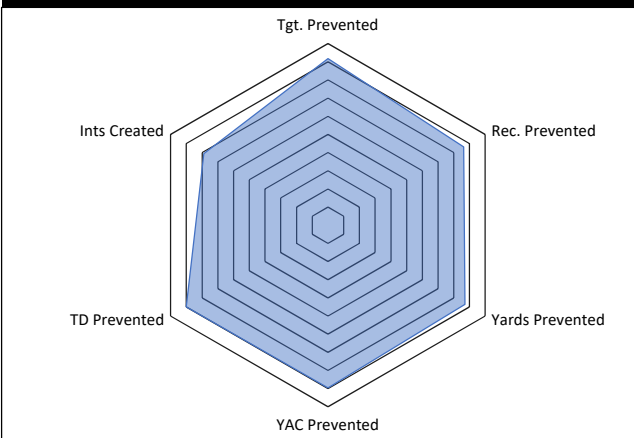

Chris Harris Jr, originally an undrafted free agent with the Denver Broncos has become one of the best veteran cornerbacks today. At age 31 Harris still has performed well on the field in 2019. In the year 5 years prior to 2019 Harris graded out with PFF at 79.1 or above. Despite the small drop off in performance in 2019, Harris can offer a new team the ability to play both on the outside and in the slot. In Harris' earlier years he was primarily tasked to cover the slot. As the roster changed in Denver, Harris moved to the boundary to cover #1 wide receivers with success. In 2019, Harris finished 19th among CB's with 325 coverage snaps in PFF's Snaps Per Reception metric. As referenced in the above spider graph, Harris excels in all areas of our metrics. Harris will offer a new team leadership and veteran presence to assist with a young secondary. With Harris' age, contract length will be limited on the open market with Harris likely seeing 2 or 3 year offers with one year of guaranteed money. Generally a player with undrafted status has trouble getting top tier money, but Harris has enough of a reputation across the league to score yet another solid contract before potential retirement. Based on Harris' performance in 2019, the OTC Valuation Tool measured Jones as a \$6,430,000 APY value.
